eagle eyes spotted a Bald Eagle flying just above us. The white head and tail of this adult Eagle swishes above us against a foggy ceiling.

What a fantastic view! Mission accomplished, almost. Sara did say she wanted to photograph an eagle. This one was a surprise. However, when birding always expect surprises. Like the other day when I stopped at gas station I noticed an immature Red-Shouldered Hawk sitting on a wire above the dumpsters. Camera in hand, click, click. My first red-shouldered pic.

Waiting for the fog to lift we listen to the sounds of the Cardinals chirping, the Blue Jay squawking and the high pitches of the Goldfinches in the background. A Red-Headed Woodpecker (see pic) breaks in but to be outdone by a Pileated Woodpecker in the distance along with a dozen American Crows. But wait, what's that caw sound without the C, just sounds like aww. It's a Fish Crow.

It's 7:30 a.m. now, and we put the kayaks in thinking the fog would lift as soon as the morning sun brakes through. To be safe we paddle along the shoreline where buoy No. 3, a mark for me, is just straight out from the point. Once past the point it's too foggy to see the buoy or the point so we sit waiting for the fog to lift. Rather than lifting it actually got thicker.

I have been out here several times now, so I'm confident about what direction we should go, or so I thought. As we're waiting we are also drifting. An hour later we spot an island and decide to paddle to land and wait out the fog. But look, right in front of us... Sara's Eagle (see pic) perched on an overhanging branch of a dead tree. Picture time. Sara got her pic.

Good job, Eagle. See you next Friday. I know, bring you a fish. OK, no problem.

Well it's 9:30 a.m. and the fog still has not lifted, but we have to head back as we both have other things

to do. The GPS on the phone shows North Bend is straight ahead. Now it wants to know if you are in your vehicle or walking. Kayaking is not an option, so I click on walking. Great, it's only a three-and-a-half hour walk.

We paddle but have to stop every few minutes to check the GPS. It was on one of those stops that I spotted a bird that looked like a flying four-pointed star with a wing span that would impress "Woody the Sheriff" of Toy Story. It was the Brown Booby (see pic) flying just inches above the water.

I said, "He's going to Buoy No. 3. Forget the GPS, follow that bird."

We did and sure enough, there is Buoy No. 3 and the Booby has landed. Sara gets her pic, and I get mine (see photo). On our way back, guess what? The American Kestrel was there waiting for us.

Great job, Sara. First time out — five Eagles, one American Kestrel, one Brown Booby and 13 other species.
